**The Sun.** British Jubilee and Coronation Issues. New York:,1937. Published for the New Jersey (USA) National Stamp Exhibition. Basic description of the stamps and printing figures. Some of the listings are not always accurate. Also contains some dealer offerings for individual sets and sheets.

**Wallace, H & A.** Silver Jubilee Stamps of George V. 1937. Contains narrative and catalogue priced pages. Much of the information duplicates Armstrong's book.
