	8/4	Hairline mark arising from Home wood Park (just to left of Brunswick Tower)
	9/1	Extra Flagstaff
2	2/1	Short Extra flagstaff
	8/6	Two parallel hairlines arising from State Apartments. Small lightning conductor on top of Right Spire of St. George's Chapel
3	1/4	Lightning conductor on left side of gable of St. George's Chapel
	2/2	Two swans in water in front of St. George's Chapel just to left of Jacob's Island
	2/5	Lightning conductor on right side of gable of St. George's Chapel
5	7/1	Flagstaff on Left side of Curfew Tower
8	9/5	Vertical hairline from Round Tower
10	7/1	Hairline mark going through right side of Brunswick Tower

Imperforate specimens with no gum found in Bechuanaland, British Honduras, Gibraltar & Newfoundland. Gold Coast 6d. Short diagonal line next to Brunswick tower similar to De la Rue 10/2 described.
